



**EASTER FLOWERS 2025** 




It's time to order your Easter flowers to decorate the church. Flowers are \$20.00

#### **APRIL BOOK CLUB**

The April Book Club selection is The Book of Longings. In 2012 National Geographic published a story about a papyrus fragment containing a reference to the wife of Jesus. The fragment was later declared fraudulent, but author Sue Monk Kidd had started thinking about the possibility of Jesus having a wife. Who would she be? How would she think and feel? Her name would be Ana. She would



come from a wealthy Jewish family, speak four languages and be a talented writer. She would have a controlling mother, father obsessed with wealth, brilliant aunt and adoptive brother named Judas who became a Zealot. When Jesus leaves home to become a follower of John the Baptizer his young wife will be left with Mary in Nazareth then sent to live with her uncle in Alexandria; thus missing the years of Jesus' active ministry. This book is written as though it is Ana's memoir. As such, it looks at Jesus through her perspective and includes only what she experiences or about which she hears.

Kidd spent five years doing meticulous historical research on the daily lives of Jews in first century Galilee and Egypt. Ana's story is an inspiring account of one woman's bold struggle to realize the passion and potential inside her while living in a time, place and culture devised to silence her longings.


